

Associate Mental Health Therapist Job Description

About the Position

EMERGE is seeking an Associate Mental Health Therapist to provide psychotherapy and other activities that support the social and emotional growth of adolescents and young adults. Candidates must have a relevant Masters degree and have some experience working with adolescents and/or young adults.

Roles and Responsibilities

- Provide individual, family and/or group psychotherapy to adolescents and young adults
- Provide therapy to other age groups to be determined (children or adults)
- Participate in 3+ hours of supervision, consultation and team meetings per week
- Maintain appropriate clinical records and documentation in a timely and professional manner
- Collaborate with other therapists and community providers
- Provide training and outreach on youth mental health needs and services available

Minimum Requirements

- Master's degree in social work, counseling or psychology
- Application with the California BBS as an ASW, AMFT or LPCC (do not need #)
- Some experience working with adolescents and/or young adults
- Excellent communication skills

Salary: Generous hourly rate to start; full-time salary with benefits after 3 months

Salary based on experience, education and training

Benefits: Health, dental, vision (or cash equivalent)

Life insurance, flex spending, 401K, training stipend

Time Off: Six weeks per year (20 days flexible time off, 10 days federal holidays)
